JUDGES RULES

- 1) WABBA INTERNATIONAL judges are selected by the President of the Judges and invited to attend the competitions. They will be chosen according to their performance at previous competitions and the President of Judges can send invitations to the best judges *before* the competitions.
- 2) New Judges must do a training course before each international competition they will judge. The cost of the training is € 100 and should be paid only the first time. After the training, the new judges will have to test judge before being allowed to judge an International Competition and will be able to do so ONLY if their performance will be satisfactory.
- 3) The number of judges during the competition must be a minimum of 7 and maximum 11.
- 4) Each judge must sit in the place selected by the Head of the jury.
- 5) Judges performance is evaluated comparing their scores with the final official score of each category. Their performance will determine if they will be reconfirmed or not.
- 6) The judge must behave according to his status and must not leave his post. No drinking, eating, taking photos or telephone calls during the competition. Speaking must be limited to the bare minimum and only about technical matters.
- 7) During the competition the judges cannot speak with someone who is not part of the jury or of the technical committee, unless authorized by the Head of Jury.
- 8) Judges cannot speak or make any gesture to the competitors.
- 9) At the end of each international competition, all the scores of the top 6 will be made public.

Official uniform (the selected judges must wear their uniform during the whole competition)

Blue jacket;
Grey trousers or skirt;
White shirt;
Official tie with WABBA INTERNATIONAL logo;
Black shoes;
Dark socks;
Black belt.
